Willingness Statement

Department of Homeland Security requires U.S. colleges and universities to obtain verification of an international student's financial resources in order to issue Form I-20. Form I-20 is the Certificate of Eligibility for Non-Immigrant (F-1) Students and endorsed by the student's financial sponsor and submitted to the U.S. Embassy with the JSSO. The student should keep a photocopy of this form to show to a U.S. Consular Officer at the time of application for an F-1 visa, and to the Customs and Border Protection Officer at a U.S. Port of Entry. The financial sponsor may be the student him/herself. There may also be more than one financial sponsor or source of funding. In that case, Willingness Statements must be submitted for all sponsors and sources. A letter may be submitted instead of this form, if it contains identical information.
