

# BIOLOGY AWARD FAQs

## Why should I apply for an award?

These are the highest honors for students in the Department of Biological Sciences, and often are included on job applications to show your success in this field. Your name is also added to the Biology Award plaques showcased in the Science Complex.

## What do I need to apply?

You need to complete the Biology Award Application form, which can be found at <https://www.towson.edu/fcsm/departments/biology/scholarships.html>. You also need to have TWO faculty members write recommendations to support your application. ## Where should I apply?

All application materials (the application and two faculty recommendations) should be emailed to the Scholarship Committee at [bioscholarships@towson.edu](mailto:bioscholarships@towson.edu). Faculty Recommendations should be emailed directly to the Scholarship Committee.

## When should I apply?

As soon as you can, so get started on that application! Your application needs to be complete and submitted by the deadline of Friday, March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022. This means you need to give the TWO faculty members writing you recommendations enough time to complete your application may not be complete!

## As a P MBBB or Environmental Science/Studies major, do I qualify for these awards?

Sorry, only Biology majors qualify for these awards.

## I qualify for more than one award<sup>2</sup> can I apply to more than one?

Of course! You can submit your application for any of the awards, as long as you meet the criteria for each.
